Dear Fran Marsala:

The Louisiana Department of Insurance ('LDI') has completed its review of Enurance Speciality Insurance Ltd.'s passporting application to renew its status as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer in the state of Louisiana.

The LDI's review of the application has resulted in the following determinations:

- Pursuant to La. R.S. 22:651(F), LAC 37:XIII.3511.A, and Advisory Letter 2021-06, ESIL is domiciled and licensed in a reciprocal jurisdiction;
- Pursuant to LAC 37:XIII.3511.E.1, an NAIC accredited jurisdiction, has determined that ESIL, has met the conditions set forth in LAC 37:XIII.3511.C;
- Pursuant to La. R.S. 22:651(F)(4) and LAC 37:XIII.3511.E.2, SPIIC submitted a properly executed Form RJ-1 dated, September 24, 2024.

Therefore, credit shall be allowed for reinsurance ceded from an insurer domiciled in this state to ESIL for the period January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025, for those lines of property and casualty that it is authorized to engage in by its domiciliary regulator.
