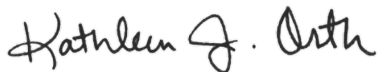
The Minnesota Department of Commerce has reviewed the reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer application submitted by Endurance Specialty Insurance Ltd. ("ESIL"). All required documentation was received.

Minnesota Statute § 60A.092, Subd. 10b(c)(i) allows the commissioner to defer to the determination of another NAIC-accredited jurisdiction. The Delaware Department of Insurance approved ESIL as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer on July 18, 2024. Therefore, Endurance Specialty Insurance Ltd.'s status as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer in Minnesota is approved for the period January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025. The company will remain on the list of assuming insurers to which cessions shall be granted credit.

The status of Endurance Specialty Insurance Ltd. as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer is contingent upon maintaining full compliance with the provisions contained in Minnesota Statute § 60A.092, Subd. 10b.
