Renewal Registration

The North Carolina Department of Insurance (the "Department") has completed its review of the renewal application of Endurance Specialty Insurance Ltd. (the "Company"), which is domiciled in Bermuda, for passporting as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer in North Carolina. The Company's renewal application is approved effective January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025. Cessions to the Company will be granted credit in accordance with North Carolina General Statute ("N.C.G.S") §58-7-21(b)(4b).

Recognition of Registration by Another NAIC Accredited Jurisdiction

As part of its renewal application, the Company has provided documentation of its continued registration as a reciprocal jurisdiction reinsurer from the Delaware Department of Insurance ("DEDOI"). The DEDOI has granted reciprocal jurisdiction status to the Company effective January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025. The Department has relied upon the determination of the DEDOI pursuant to N.C.G.S §58-7-21(b)(4b)d. **Should the DEDOI change its determination regarding the Company's reciprocal jurisdiction status, the Company is required to notify the Department within 10 days after receiving notice of the change.**
